# About Preplanning

Preplanning, or prearranging, is the process of planning a funeral before the time of death. Without prearranging, a funeral is usually planned by a small group of family members who have little warning or time to plan a funeral. Prearrangement relieves your family of that responsibility, giving peace of mind to you and your family.

## **What if I change my mind about arrangements?**

Our funeral home is based on service to families, we respect your wishes at all times and strive to meet the special needs and requests of you and your family, whether planning ahead or at the time of need. Together, we can adapt plans to meet your changing needs or desires.

## **What if I prearrange in my community and die away from home?**

If you are traveling or visiting another city when death occurs, your survivors should contact us immediately. We will make any necessary arrangements to bring you back home.

## **I would like to prearrange, but what if I move?**

Because of the flexible nature of our pre-need contracts, your preferences for prearrangement may be transferred at any time in the event you move. We can even recommend a reputable funeral home in your new community.

# About Prefunding

Funds used for prefunding are placed in a funeral insurance policy or trust account designed specifically for funeral planning. These funds are protected and used only for funeral expenses.

## **Do I have to pre-fund to prearrange?**

Not at all! Many people choose to pre-fund their wishes in full ahead of their passing, but any amount funded is totally acceptable; even if that amount is zero.

## **What happens to my money when I pre-fund?**

Funds are set aside in a type of life insurance called 'burial insurance'. These funds are not vested in anything, and are at no risk.

## **Will prefunding disqualify me from receiving medical assistance?**

Our funding options can be made completely compliant with medical assistance standards, meaning you can completely fund your funeral and those funds will not count as assets in your medical assistance determination. In fact, in the pursuit of qualifying for assistance, many will choose to 'spend down' their funds by placing them in a designated funeral account.

# Notification Of Passing

At the time of death, your survivors may use this section to contact those who will need to be notified of your passing. Death certificates may or may not need to be provided to each, as they will all have differing policies. Photocopies may suffice in many situations.

The funeral director will collect necessary information from you during the prearrangement or from your survivors at the time of death to file the death certificates. Death certificates are then certified and printed by the state vital records office and will be ordered by the funeral director on your behalf.

In general, the following usually need to be contacted by next of kin at the time of passing, and may or may not require a death certificate:

- **Social Security**

The funeral home will provide the initial death notification to social security, but cannot settle any changes to benefits. Call social security at 800-772-1213 to begin this process. Social security will notify Medicare and Medicaid of the death.

- **Wills and Real Estate**

Contact the attorney with whom the will was drafted. If no will is in place, it is still advisable to contact an attorney to begin the process of settling the estate.

- **Credit Reporting Agencies**

Contact Transunion, Equifax, and Experian to minimize chances of identity theft.

- **Veterans Benefits**

Contact the Veterans Services Office of the county of residence.
